



Quisiera comenzar agradeciendo especialmente a la editorial Papel Cosido y a las autoridades de la Facultad de Artes de la Universidad Nacional de La Plata por hacer posible esta edición, a pesar de los tiempos pandémicos que nos aquejan, con todo lo que conlleva.


El nombre de este álbum hace referencia a aquellos proyectos que quedan archivados, que por algún motivo olvidamos y dejamos a su suerte. Cuando volvemos sobre ellos cobran vida propia, a veces incluso sentimos un extrañamiento, como si los hubiera hecho otra persona. Con este trabajo rindo homenaje a esas criaturas que crecen en *silencio* y que, a veces, logran salir.

Las músicas que presentamos tienen como hilo conductor el uso de materiales relacionados con el tango y el candombe, de allí la referencia al tango *Malena* con letra de Homero Manzi y la alusión a la *orilla*, al ir y venir de las aguas barrosas del Río de La Plata.

Siempre es un riesgo escribir músicas que parten de la *performance*, en ausencia total o parcial de soportes escritos y en vínculo con los micro desfasajes rítmicos. Lo asumimos por necesidad, las criaturas precisan salir de su escondite. Algunas lo hicieron antes guiadas por tambores y guitarras, y ahora se lanzan en papel (digital) a la espera de ser acunadas por tubos (pinchados) de metal.

Orquesta Gallito tuvo un comienzo próspero, pudo tocarse en distintos escenarios, como dijimos, al resguardo de tambores y guitarras. Pero luego quedó dormida hasta tener la oportunidad de ser versionada en el formato de cuarteto de saxofones gracias a Federico Jaureguiberry y a Johannes Thorell en el *Nordic Sax Festival*. Al tocarla en este formato observé que podía funcionar mejor que en su versión original, aun sin guitarras y tambores. Tiempo después, el cuarteto de saxofones *Roya Quartet*, con la fuerza que lo caracteriza, dio vida a *Orilla*, y comprendí entonces que era necesario llevar varias ideas —circunstancialmente abandonadas— al formato de cuarteto de saxofones.






